

# YESHUA IS COMING SOONER THAN YOU THINK!

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Many proclaim when Yeshua comes, the battle is over. However, in my studies of the Hebrew Brit Hadashah (New Testament), Yeshua is coming sooner than you think. And Yeshua's coming is a sign of the battle beginning, not ending. Keep in mind there is a difference between Yeshua "coming" and Yeshua "returning". It is also important to note that Yeshua is coming to battle *with* us, but Yehovah is fighting *through* us.

## YESHUA CONTINUALLY COMING

In a discussion I've had with others, the topic was brought out about Yeshua's coming in 1 Corinthians 15:23.

אדם אדם בדתו ראשית הוא במשיח ובסוף אלו של משיח הם גם כך בבוואו  
"Adam, a man's (adam) first law/covenant is in Messiah. And in the end, those belonging to Messiah are also the same *at his coming*" 1 Corinthians 15:23<sup>1</sup> (emphasis mine)

Notice in 1 Corinthians 15:23 uses the verb בבוואו (bē bo'ō) a Hebrew infinitive construct with a preposition "ב" (bet) prefix meaning "in", "with" or "by". The bet prefix with the infinitive construct verb is an ongoing action of "coming". If the author used the "כ" (kaf) prefix, it would be an action just performed. In other words, ***it is not a one-time event!*** Furthermore, scripture confirms we will see Yeshua coming with our own eyes as described in Zechariah 12:10, Revelation 1:7 as well as in Matthew 24:30b as stated below:

אז יראה אדם סימן בן האלוה בשמים ואז ילילו כל שבטי הארץ ויראו בן הבתולה בא בעבי השמים ברב כח וצלם ודמות  
"... And they saw the Son of the Virgin *coming*\* in the clouds of the heavens. With great power, image and likeness" Matt 24:30b<sup>1</sup> (emphasis mine)

\*Note: The Hebrew participle active verb, "coming" in Matthew 24:30b describes *one who is coming*.

## THE 7 SPIRITS OF YEHOVAH REVEALED

Now consider Isaiah 11:2-5 describing the Spirit of Yehovah that will rest upon the coming Messiah.

“The Spirit of Yehovah shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of Yehovah. His delight is in the fear of Yehovah, and he shall not judge by the sight of his eyes, nor decide by the hearing of his ears; but with righteousness he shall judge the poor and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; he shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall slay the wicked. And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and trustworthiness the girdle of his waist.” Isa 11:2-5

Interestingly, people assume the “Spirit of Yehovah” is the first of the seven Spirits, when in fact, the Spirit of Yehovah *encompasses* all seven Spirits within him.<sup>2</sup> Thus, when counting the seven Spirits of Yehovah (i.e. Spirits of Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Might, Knowledge, Fear of Yehovah), we are left with six spirits, not seven. However, in verses 4 and 5, Isaiah continues with his description of the Spirit of Yehovah by describing one who is just and right-ruling. Now consider, Isaiah 28:6, “and a Spirit of right-ruling to him who sits in right-ruling, and strength to those who turn back the battle at the gate.” Isaiah 11:4-5 appears to describe the same Spirit of right-ruling defined in Isaiah 28:6. Therefore, the Spirit of right-ruling would be counted as the seventh Spirit of Yehovah.

Secondly, Revelation 5:6 says, “And I looked and saw in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders a Lamb standing, as having been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are *the seven Spirits of Elohim* sent out into all the earth.

## HOLY SPIRIT VS SPIRIT OF YEHOVAH

It is important to note the Spirit of Yehovah, and the Holy Spirit are two separate entities from God. In Joel 2:28, Acts 2:17-18, Yehovah says he will “*pour out* his Spirit upon all flesh...” (שֶׁפַךְ – ‘eshpok) and the seven Spirits of Yehovah are *named* in Isaiah 11:2-5, 28:6 and is *resting* upon the Messiah. The seven Spirits of Yehovah are also *sent* נִשְׁלַח (nishlach) into all the earth in Revelation 5:6. Both Spirits are Yehovah and appears to be two different manifestations of the same God (Elohim).

Keep in mind, the Holy Spirit is not a third person of Yehovah but *is* Yehovah. Consider Leviticus 24:16 an Israeli woman’s son blasphemed and cursed the name of Yehovah, and his punishment was death by stoning. Furthermore, Yehovah continued by saying that any native or stranger who does the same would suffer the same consequences. That is why it is an unpardonable sin to blaspheme and curse the Holy Spirit because the Holy Spirit *is* Yehovah as defined in 2 Corinthians 3:17, John 14:8-11; 15:26.

Lastly, the battle is beginning, and we are not alone —Yeshua is coming sooner than you think! No doubt, all eyes will see him in the clouds at the end when he chooses to reveal himself physically. However, Yeshua comes in the Spirit of Yehovah to stand and battle with us, *and* we will also have the Holy Spirit, Yehovah within us!

Undoubtably, the Holy Spirit will manifest through us with signs and wonders. But how the Spirit of Yehovah resting upon Yeshua will manifest is a mystery. Perhaps as the Spirit of Might as it did on Sampson (Judges 14:6,19, 15:14)? Or perhaps, the Spirit of Wisdom as it appeared on Solomon (1 Kings 3:7-17)? These are assumptions, of course. But it is clear, Yeshua is continually coming and will be with us in the Spirit of Yehovah. Be encouraged, we are not fighting this war alone!

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
